When Dennis and Judy Groth bought the property that is now the Groth Oakville Estate it was their vision to make great Cabernet Sauvignon. This dream came true when their 1985 Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon became the first wine from California to receive a perfect 100 point score from Robert Parker.

In the ensuing years, Groth has built a reputation on making great wines that are approachable and drinkable on release, and yet known for their decades long ageability.
